GITB Official FAM tour of Rajasthan for registered foreign tour operators from April 26 – 30, 2017

Post Tour No 1: Jaipur – Bundi – Udaipur – Deogarh – Jaipur (3N/ 4 Days)

26-Apr-17	Pickup Jaipur – Bundi After breakfast drive to Bundi . Upon arrival and check in hotel. P.M visit to Taragarh fort and Sukhmahal. Overnight in Bundi .
27-Apr-17	Bundi – Udaipur After breakfast drive to Udaipur . Arrive and check in hotel. After visit on a sightseeing tour of Udaipur. Founded in 1568 by Maharana Udai Singh, the elegant city of Udaipur is called the Venice of the East. Begin your tour with a visit to the City Palace with its mirrored walls, ivory doors, colored glass windows, inlaid marble balconies and peacock courtyard. Also visit the lovely Sahelion-ki-bari gardens, the Jagdish temple and the local Museum. In the evening, enjoy a motor launch on the placid waters of Lake Pichola. Also visit the Jag Mandir Palace, a lovely island palace in the middle of the lake. Overnight in Udaipur.
28-Apr-17	Udaipur – Deogarh After breakfast drive to Deogarh. Arrive and check in hotel. Overnight in Hotel.
29-Apr-17	Deogarh – Jaipur After breakfast drive to Jaipur enroute visit Pushkar. Arrive Jaipur and transfer to Jaipur airport / Railway Station in time to board to your onward destination.

Post Tour No 2: Jaipur – Jodhpur – Bera– Kumbhalgarh – Jaipur (3N/ 4 Days)

26-Apr-17	Pickup Jaipur – Jodhpur After breakfast drive to Jodhpur enroute Lunch at Nimajgarh.P.M leisure. Overnight in Jodhpur.

27-Apr-17	<p>Jodhpur – Bera After breakfast Proceed on a sightseeing tour of Jodhpur beginning with the formidable hilltop Mehrangarh Fort. A series of gates named Jayapol, Fatepol, Lahapol etc. lead into the Fort. Visit the palaces located inside the fort - <i>Moti Mahal</i> or Pearl Palace, <i>Sukh Mahal</i> or Pleasure Palace and the <i>Phool Mahal</i> or Flower Palace. Continue the tour to visit the Jaswant Thada, a marble cenotaph built in 1899 as a memorial to Maharaja Jaswant Singh II. After drive to Bera . Arrive and check in hotel. Overnight in Hotel.</p>
28-Apr-17	<p>Bera –Kumbhalgarh After breakfast drive to Kumbhalgarh . Arrive and check in hotel. After visit Kumbhalgarh fort. Overnight in Hotel.</p>
29-Apr-17	<p>Kumbhalgarh – Jaipur After breakfast drive to Jaipur enroute visit Pushkar later drive to Jaipur . Arrive Jaipur and transfer to Jaipur airport / Railway Station in time to board to your onward destination.</p>

Post Tour No 3: Jaipur – Sariska – Swai Madhopur – Jaipur (3N/ 4 Days)

26-Apr-17	<p>Pickup Jaipur – Sariska After breakfast drive to Sariska enroute visit Abhaneri. Overnight in Hotel.</p>
27-Apr-17	<p>Sariska – Swai Madhopur (Ranthambore) After breakfast drive to Ranthambore . Arrive and check in hotel. Evening enjoy a game viewing inside the verdant jungles of the Ranthambore National Park. Stay overnight at a hotel/resort in Ranthambore.</p>
28-Apr-17	<p>Ranthambore Morning enjoy a game viewing inside the verdant jungles of the Ranthambore National Park. Stay overnight at a resort in Ranthambore.</p>
29-Apr-17	<p>Ranthambore – Jaipur After breakfast drive to Jaipur . Arrive Jaipur and transfer to Jaipur airport / Railway Station in time to board to your onward destination.</p>

Post Tour No 4: Jaipur – Bikaner – Jaisalmer – Jodhpur (4N/ 5 Days)

26-Apr-17	<p>Pickup Jaipur – Bikaner After breakfast drive to Bikaner . Upon arrival and check in hotel. Proceed for sightseeing tour visiting the 16th century magnificent Junagarh Fort. Other places of interest include the famous camel breeding farm just outside the town (closed on Sunday). and the local bazaars in the afternoon. Overnight in Bikaner.</p>
27-Apr-17	<p>Bikaner – Jaisalmer After breakfast drive to Jaisalmer . Arrive and check in hotel. Rest of the day. Overnight in Jaisalmer.</p>
28-Apr-17	<p>Jaisalmer After breakfast visit for a sightseeing tour of Jaisalmer. Begin at the Jaisalmer Fort, built in 1156 by Rawal Jaisal, atop the Trikuta hill. Still inhabited, there are palaces and bazaars within the fort walls. Also visit the <i>havelis</i> which are palatial homes with carved stone facades and owned by wealthy merchants. Other attractions include Ganga Sagar Tank and Museum, housing many small temples and shrines. In the afternoon, visit the Sam Sand Dunes. Take a camel ride on the sand dunes to view the sunset. The Rajasthani backdrop, the sunset and the camel ride make the entire outing an unforgettable experience. Overnight in Jaisalmer.</p>

29-Apr-17	Jaisalmer – Jodhpur After breakfast drive to Jodhpur. Arrive and check in hotel. Proceed on a sightseeing tour of Jodhpur beginning with the formidable hilltop Mehrangarh Fort. A series of gates named Jayapol, Fatepol, Lahapol etc. lead into the Fort. Visit the palaces located inside the fort - <i>Moti Mahal</i> or Pearl Palace, <i>Sukh Mahal</i> or Pleasure Palace and the <i>Phool Mahal</i> or Flower Palace. Continue the tour to visit the Jaswant Thada, a marble cenotaph built in 1899 as a memorial to Maharaja Jaswant Singh II. Overnight in Jodhpur.
30-Apr-17	Jodhpur – Jaipur After breakfast drive to Jaipur enroute visit Pushkar. Arrive Jaipur and transfer to Jaipur airport / Railway Station in time to board to your onward destination.

2. To register for the post tours, please write to RATO with the Post Tour Number that you wish to take. RATO will reconfirm your booking on the post tour.
3. There is a registration fee of \$ 100 **(Non Refundable)** per person. It's a token cost for taking the post FAM tours from Jaipur to Jaipur which includes; Accommodation, transportation, complete meals for the entire trip, entrance fee at all the monuments and guide/escort charges. You are requested to make the payment on April 24, 2017 at the RATO counter during the registration time at the registration area.
4. **Please note that all the tours will end in Jaipur. You will have to make your own travel arrangements from Jaipur to New Delhi to catch your onward flight.**
